STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend section three of chapter seventy-two of the revised statutes, relating to probate bonds.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

That section three of chapter seventy-two of the
2 revised statutes, be and is hereby amended by
3 striking out the words "after six years from its
4 date," and insert instead thereof, "in the exercise
5 of a just discretion," so that said section when
6 amended shall read as follows:

7 *Sect. 3.* In the application of any surety in
8 such bond, the judge of probate, on due notice to
9 all parties interested, may in the exercise of a just
10 discretion discharge him from all liability for any

11 subsequent, but not for any prior breaches thereof,
12 and require a new bond of the principal with sure-
13 ties approved by him.
