## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT to authorize the Kennebec Log Driving Company to erect a boom across the Kennebec river at Brown's island.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The Kennebec Log Driving Com-

- 2 pany is authorized to erect and maintain a boom
- 3 across the Kennebec river at Brown's island, near
- 4 the south lines of Vassalborough and Sidney, and
- 5 for that purpose shall have all the powers, rights,
- 6 privileges and immunities, and shall be subject
- 7 to all the duties and obligations granted to, and
- 8 imposed upon the Kennebec Boom Company by
- 9 special act of eighteen hundred and sixty-two,
- 10 chapter one hundred and eighty-nine, approved
- 11 March nineteen, eighteen hundred and sixty-two.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect from its 2 approval.
