STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT to authorize the Kennebec Log Driving Company to erect a boom across the Kennebec river at Brown's island.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Kennebec Log Driving Company is authorized to erect and maintain a boom across the Kennebec river at Brown's island, near the south lines of Vassalborough and Sidney, and for that purpose shall have all the powers, rights, privileges and immunities, and shall be subject to all the duties and obligations granted to, and imposed upon the Kennebec Boom Company by special act of eighteen hundred and sixty-two, chapter one hundred and eighty-nine, approved March nineteen, eighteen hundred and sixty-two.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect from its
