STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT to abolish the December term of the
supreme judicial court, in the county of Oxford.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

The term of the supreme judicial court, now
2 required by law to be held in the county of Oxford,
3 on the first Tuesday of December annually, is
4 hereby abolished.
