STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT to abolish the December term of the supreme judicial court, in the county of Oxford.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The term of the supreme judicial court, now

- 2 required by law to be held in the county of Oxford,
- 3 on the first Tuesday of December annually, is
- 4 hereby abolished.
