## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE.

AN ACT explanatory of section twenty-five of chapter twenty-seven of the revised statutes, as amended by section three of chapter two hundred and forty-seven of the public laws of eighteen hundred and eighty, in relation to the sale of cider.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The provisions of section twenty-five of chapter

- 2 twenty-seven, of the revised statutes, as amended
- 3 by section three of chapter two hundred and forty-
- 4 seven of the public laws of eighteen hundred and
- 5 eighty, shall not apply to the sale of unadulterated
- 6 cider when sold in quantities of less than five gal-
- 7 lons, unless the same is sold to be used as a bever-
- 8 age or for tippling purposes.
