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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
EIGHTY-ONE.

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AN ACT explanatory of section twenty-five of chapter twenty-seven of the revised statutes, as amended by section three of chapter two hundred and forty-seven of the public laws of eighteen hundred and eighty, in relation to the sale of cider.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

The provisions of section twenty-five of chapter 2 twenty-seven, of the revised statutes, as amended 3 by section three of chapter two hundred and forty- 4 seven of the public laws of eighteen hundred and 5 eighty, shall not apply to the sale of unadulterated 6 cider when sold in quantities of less than five gal- 7 lons, unless the same is sold to be used as a bever- 8 age or for tipping purposes.
