STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE to enable the state superintendent of common schools to hold teachers' meetings as provided in item four of section seventy-one, chapter eleven, of the revised statutes.

Resolved, That the sum of six hundred dollars 2 be, and the same is hereby appropriated for the 3 year eighteen hundred and eighty-three, and the 4 like sum for the year eighteen hundred and eighty- 5 four, the same to be taken from any school money 6 belonging to the state, to enable the state superin- 7 tendent of common schools to defray the expenses 8 of holding teachers' meetings in the several coun- 9 ties of this state, one meeting or more to be held in 10 each county in the state, which sums shall be ex- 11 pended under the direction of the state superin- 12 tendent, all bills for which shall be audited by the 13 governor and council; *provided, however,* that no

14 bills shall be paid from said sums except for adver-
15 tising such meetings and paying actual travelling
16 expenses of speakers and lecturers not residing in
17 the counties in which such meetings are held.
