STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT to condense and amend section one, of
chapter ninety-two, of the public laws of eighteen
hundred and seventy-three.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section one, of chapter ninety-two, of the public
2 laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-three, is
3 hereby condensed and amended by inserting there-
4 in the words, "and for the erection and mainten-
5 ance of monuments, and for the benefit of public
6 cemeteries and lots therein," so that the same sec-
7 tion, condensed and amended, shall be as follows:
8 *Sect. 1.* Any city or town may receive money
9 by donation or legacy, in trust, for benevolent,
10 religious, or educational purposes, and for the

11 erection and maintenance of monuments, and for
12 the benefit of public cemeteries and lots therein;
13 *provided* that the city or town shall lawfully con-
14 sent.
