STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of an appropriation to build a bridge across Macwahoc stream, in Macwahoc plantation, county of Aroostook.

Resolved, That the sum of six hundred dollars 2 be, and is hereby appropriated to build a bridge 3 across the Macwahoc stream, in Macwahoc planta- 4 tion, the same being on the military road from 5 Lincoln to Houlton, and that the same be expended 6 under the direction of the county commissioners of 7 said county of Aroostook.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The Macwahoc stream is crossed by the old Military road from Bangor to Houlton, and the State of Maine became obligated to the State of Massachusetts, on assuming the ownership of said road, to keep it in repair. The bridge across said stream has become old and unsafe for loaded teams to cross.

Therefore, the citizens of said plantation ask for the necessary appropriation from the State, to whom this road belongs, to build said bridge.
