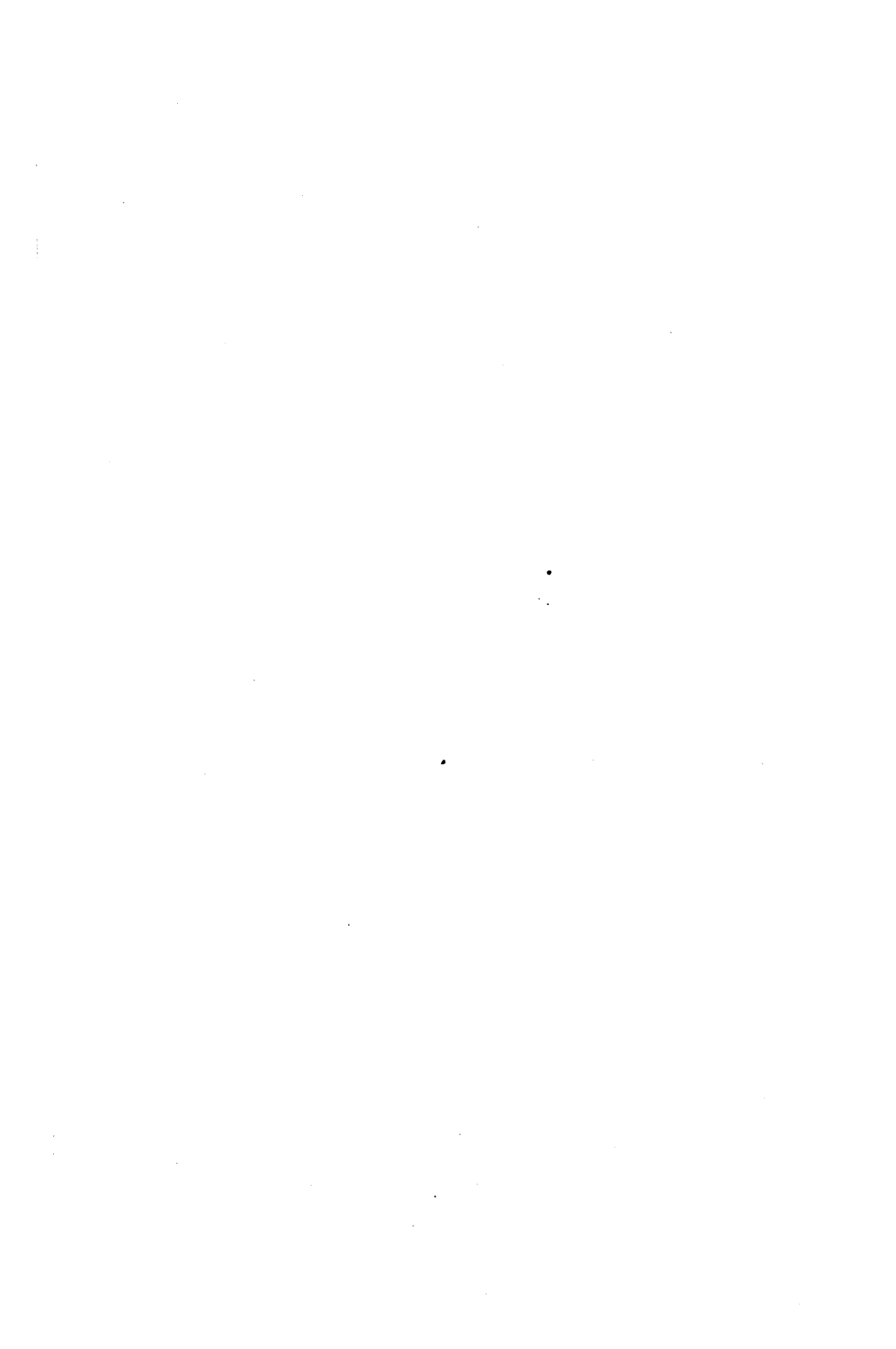

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT to allow women to vote in the election of
school officers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Every woman who is a citizen of the state, of
2 twenty-one years of age and upwards, (except
3 persons excluded by section one of article two of
4 the constitution for causes other than of sex) who
5 has resided in the state for the term of three
6 months next preceding any election of school offi-
7 cers in any town or plantation where her residence
8 is so established, shall have the right to vote in
9 the election of such officers.
