STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Lee Normal Academy.

Resolved, That the sum of six hundred dollars is
2 hereby annually appropriated out of any money in
3 the treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the
4 term of four years, to Lee Normal Academy, an
5 institution of learning located in the town of Lee,
6 in the county of Penobscot; *provided, however,*
7 that this appropriation is made on the express con-
8 ditions that the trustees of said institution shall
9 maintain and keep in operation, a school equal in
10 rank and grade of teaching with a first-class acad-
11 emy, and also maintain a normal department equal
12 in grade to that required by law of the state normal
13 schools; *and provided, further,* that the governor
14 and council and superintendent of common schools
15 shall have a right at any and all times to visit said

16 school when the same shall be in operation; and if
17 in the opinion of the governor and council said in-
18 stitution at any time hereafter shall fail to fulfil the
19 conditions contained in this resolve they may in
20 their discretion withhold the appropriation herein
21 granted.
