STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-THREE

AN ACT relating to the laying out of ways across
railroads.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. No way shall be laid out through or
2 across any land or right of way of any railroad
3 corporation, used for station purposes, unless after
4 notice and hearing the railroad commissioners
5 adjudge that public necessity requires it.

SECT. 2. When any way is laid out across a
2 railroad, the railroad commissioners upon applica-
3 tion of the parties owning or operating such rail-
4 road shall upon notice and hearing determine the
5 manner and conditions of crossing such railroad.

SECT. 3. All adjudications of the railroad com-
2 missioners relating to ways shall be recorded in the
3 office in which the location of the way is by law to
4 be recorded.

SECT. 4. This act takes effect when approved.
