STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT relating to the taxation of horse railroad
companies.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Horse railroad corporations and
2 associations are hereby made subject to the pro-
3 visions of the act entitled "an act relating to the
4 taxation of railroads," approved March seventeenth,
5 one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one, except
6 that the tax shall be ascertained as follows: when
7 the gross average receipts per mile shall not
8 exceed one thousand dollars, the tax shall be equal
9 to one-tenth of one per centum on the gross trans-
10 portation receipts; and for each one thousand

11 dollars additional average gross receipts per mile,
12 or fractional part thereof, the rate shall be
13 increased one-tenth of one per centum.

SECT. 2. This act takes effect when approved.
