## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
EIGHTY-THREE.

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AN ACT to amend section three of chapter one hundred and twenty-five of the public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-nine, relating to salaries.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section three of chapter one hundred and twenty-five of the public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-nine is hereby amended by striking out the words "one hundred and fifty," and by inserting instead thereof the words "two hundred;" also by striking out the words "said officers named in this section are to do and perform all services similar to those done by the officers who held these positions for the legislature of

10 eighteen hundred and seventy-eight;" so that the  
11 same section, amended, shall be as follows:

12 *Sect. 3.* Secretary of the senate and the clerk  
13 of the house of representatives, six hundred dol-  
14 lars each, in full for all services; assistant secre-  
15 tary and assistant clerk, three hundred dollars  
16 each, in full for all services; messenger and assis-  
17 tant messengers to senate and to house, two hun-  
18 dred dollars to each in full.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-  
2 proved.
