STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of aid in repairing bridge across
Fish river.

Resolved, That the sum of two hundred and
2 fifty dollars be and is hereby appropriated out of
3 any funds not otherwise appropriated, to aid in re-
4 pairing bridge across Fish river, in the town of
5 Fort Kent, Aroostook county, to be expended
6 under the direction of the county commissioners
7 of said county.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This bridge was built some ten years since, on one of the most public roads in that town, at a cost of about three thousand dollars. It is now out of repair and unsafe to cross. The people of this town are poor and unable to put this bridge in repair without help, therefore they ask the State to assist them.
