AN ACT to amend section three of chapter fifty-nine  
of the revised statutes relating to the intermarriage  
of white persons with negroes, mulattoes and Indians.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section three of chapter fifty-nine of the revised  
2 statutes, is hereby amended by striking out in the  
3 first and second lines, the words following: “no  
4 white person shall intermarry with a negro, Indian  
5 or mulatto and,” so that said section as amended  
6 shall read “no insane person or idiot shall be cap-  
7 able of contracting marriage.”
