STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE instructing the secretary of state to purchase reports of Maine Historical Society.

That the secretary of state is authorized to contract with the Maine Historical Society for the volumes of its proceedings and collections to be hereafter published, and commencing with volume eight heretofore issued; *provided*, they can be purchased at a price not exceeding one dollar and fifty cents per volume, containing not a less number of pages than said eighth volume, and further *provided*, that the aggregate amount paid in any one year shall not exceed one thousand dollars. Said volumes shall be distributed by the secretary of state, in the same way, and to the same parties, that he is now authorized to distribute the acts and resolves of the state legislature.
