STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT amendatory of and additional to chapter
eight of the revised statutes, relating to the duties
of county treasurers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Section ten of chapter eight of the
2 revised statutes is hereby amended by adding
3 thereto the words "this section shall not apply to
4 the county of Cumberland," so that said section.
5 as amended shall read as follows:
6 *Sect. 10.* He shall publish annually, in the month
7 of January, in some newspaper in the county, if
8 any, to be designated by the county commission-
9 ers, otherwise in the state paper, a full and fair
10 statement of the financial concerns of his county,
11 with the items of receipts and expenditures. This

12 section shall not apply to the county of Cumber-
13 land.

SECT. 2. Chapter eight of the revised statutes
2 is hereby further amended by adding thereto the
3 following section:

4 *Sect. 19.* The treasurer of the county of Cum-
5 berland shall, at the end of each year, in connec-
6 tion with the commissioners of said county, make
7 out a statement of its financial condition, showing
8 in detail all monies received into and paid out of
9 the treasury of said county, and such other facts
10 and statistics as may be necessary to exhibit the
11 true state of the finances of the county; and
12 shall publish in pamphlet form a reasonable num-
13 ber of copies for distribution among the citizens
14 of the county.
