EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend section one of chapter sixty-four of the public laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-one.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section one of chapter sixty-four of the public
2 laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-one is
3 amended by adding the following words to said
4 section: "And in jails containing workshops, the
5 jailers shall receive for every prisoner laboring in
6 said shops, twenty-five cents per week, in addition
7 to the sum above provided."
