STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT relating to the Insurance Commissioner.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. The secretary of state shall be in-
2 surance commissioner by virtue of his office; he
3 may administer oaths in the performance of his
4 official duties, in any part of the state, and at any
5 time; he shall keep a correct account of all his
6 doings, and of all matters relating to the subject
7 of insurance and insurance companies, on which
8 he is officially called to act, and shall keep an accu-
9 rate account of all money received by him as
10 insurance commissioner, and pay the same to the
11 state treasurer, and shall settle his accounts with
12 the governor and council in the months of Janu-
13 ary and July of each year.

SECT. 2. The compensation of the insurance
2 commissioner shall be nine hundred dollars a year,
3 in full.

SECT. 3. Section forty-four of chapter forty-
2 nine of the revised statutes, and chapter sixty-
3 three of the public laws of eighteen hundred and
4 eighty-one is hereby repealed.

SECT. 4. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.
