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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
EIGHTY-THREE.

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AN ACT to amend chapter seventy-three, section  
twenty-six of the revised statutes, in relation to the  
registry of deeds.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. That chapter seventy-three, section  
2 twenty-six of the revised statutes, be amended, by  
3 inserting after the word "all" in the second line,  
4 the following words, viz: "or if any deed is record-  
5 ed in the wrong county or registry district and  
6 lost," so that the section as amended shall read as  
7 follows:

8 *Sect. 26.* If a deed conveying lands in more  
9 than one county is lost before recorded in all, or if  
10 any deed is recorded in the wrong county or regis-

11 try district and lost, a certified copy from a regis-  
12 try where it has been recorded, may be recorded  
13 in any other county, and have the same effect as  
14 a record of the original.

SECT. 2. This act shall shall take effect from its  
2 approval.
