STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT in relation to the salary of the judge of
the superior court for the county of Cumberland.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows .*

SECTION 1. So much of section one of chapter
2 one hundred and fifty of the public laws of the
3 year eighteen hundred and seventy-nine as relates
4 to the compensation of the judge of the superior
5 court for the county of Cumberland is hereby re-
6 pealed, and the compensation of said judge shall
7 be the same as it was previous to the passage of
8 the statute aforesaid.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.
