STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE for the purchase of the Maine State Year Book and Legislative Manual for the years eighteen hundred and eighty-three and eighteen hundred and eighty-four.

Resolved, That the secretary of state be authorized
2 to contract for three hundred copies of the Maine
3 State Year Book and Legislative Manual for the
4 year eighteen hundred and eighty-three at a cost
5 not to exceed four hundred and fifty dollars;
6 seventy-five copies of the above named number,
7 octavo, suitable for binding with documents; one
8 copy to be delivered on or before the first day of
9 May next to each officer and member of the legis-
10 lature, and balance to the secretary of state for the
11 heads of departments for their use.

12 Also six hundred copies of the same for the
13 year eighteen hundred and eighty-four, at a cost
14 not to exceed nine hundred dollars; seventy-five
15 copies of the above number, octavo, to bind with
16 documents and for exchange with other states.
17 One copy to be delivered to each officer and mem-
18 ber of the legislature on or before the first day of
19 May eighteen hundred and eighty-four, and the
20 balance to the secretary of state for the heads of
21 departments for their use and for the officers and
22 members of the legislature for the year eighteen
23 hundred and eighty-five.
