STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the Maine State Library.

Resolved, That the sum of five hundred dollars
2 be appropriated for the state library for each of
3 the years A. D. eighteen hundred and eighty-three
4 and eighteen hundred and eighty-four, in addition
5 to the sum allowed by law, for the purchase of
6 books and incidental expenses.
