IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT making Sunday a close time for game and  
birds of all kinds.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Sunday is hereby made a close time,  
2 on which day it shall not be lawful for any person  
3 to hunt, kill or destroy game or birds of any kind,  
4 under the penalties imposed for the hunting, killing  
5 or destroying the same, during any close time now  
6 established by law.

SECT. 2. This act shall not be construed to  
2 repeal or diminish the penalties already imposed  
3 for any violation of the Sunday laws.
