IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT relating to seizure of fish and game under  
the fish and game laws.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Any person whose fish or game has been seized  
2 for violation of any fish or game law, shall have  
3 such fish or game, so seized, returned to him on  
4 giving to the officer a bond with sufficient sureties,  
5 residents of this state, in double the amount of the  
6 fine for such violation; conditioned, that if the  
7 final judgment for such alleged violation shall be  
8 guilty, he will within thirty days thereafter pay  
9 such fine and costs. If such person neglects or re-  
10 fuses to give such bond and take the fish or game,  
11 so seized, he shall have no action against the officer  
12 for such seizure or loss thereof.
