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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
EIGHTY-THREE.

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AN ACT to amend section two of chapter twenty-two  
of the revised statutes relating to fences.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section two of chapter twenty-two of the revised  
2 statutes is amended by striking out the words  
3 “inclosed with fences,” in the first line, the word  
4 “the,” in the second line, and by substituting the  
5 word “lands” for “enclosures,” in the third line,  
6 so that said section as amended shall read as fol-  
7 lows:

8 *Sect. 2.* The occupants of lands shall maintain  
9 partition fences between their own and adjoining  
10 lands, in equal shares, while both parties continue  
11 to improve them.
