EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT to authorize the construction of a bridge over tide  
waters between Orr's Island and Bailey's Island.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Authority is hereby given to lay out, con-  
2 struct and maintain a bridge, with a draw suited to the  
3 purposes of navigation, across and over the tide waters  
4 separating Orr's Island from Bailey's Island, in the town  
5 of Harpswell.

SECT. 2. The town of Harpswell shall have all the  
2 powers relating to said bridge and its construction which  
3 are provided by law in case of town ways.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
