STATEMENT OF FACTS.

J. Albert Hurd of Caswell Plantation, in Aroostook County, is a settler on parts of lots one hundred and fifty and one hundred and fifty-three in said plantation, and has performed all settling duties required by law to entitle him to a deed from the State, except building. That the largest part of the portion of lot one hundred and fifty is not suitable for tillage, with no lumber and very little wood, the lot having been burned over.
