RESOLVE to aid in constructing a road from Shirley
Mills in Piscataquis County to the Forks of the
Kennebec River, in the County of Somerset.

Resolved, That the sum of five thousand dollars

- 2 be and the same is hereby appropriated to be ex-
- 3 pended by the Land Agent under the direction of
- 4 the Governor and Council, in making the road
- 5 leading from Shirley Mills in Piscataquis County
- 6 to the Forks of the Kennebec River in the county
- 7 of Somerset, as laid out by the County Commis-
- 8 sioners of Piscataquis and Somerset Counties.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The proposed road is to connect Shirley Mills in the county of Piscataquis with The Forks in the county of Somerset, a distance of sixteen miles, and will run through a region almost entirely uninhabited. Along the line of the road are lands suitable for settling purposes which are not now available for want of such a road. The road will establish a connection between the Piscataquis and Penobscot country on the east and the Kennebec country on the west, and be of great value in promoting the development of a large section of the State. It is estimated that this road will cost from eight to ten thousand dollars, and the scattered inhabitants of this region are not able to build it.
