STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT relating to the compensation of County Commissioners of the County of Penobscot.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Each county commissioner for Penob-2 scot County shall receive two dollars and fifty 3 cents per day while actually employed in the ser-4 vice of the county, including the time spent in 5 traveling, for which he shall have ten cents a mile 6 for the distance actually traveled; but he shall not 7 have more than one travel in the same hearing or 8 session nor for more than two adjournments of any 9 regular term, nor for service or travel on more 10 than one petition or case at the same time, nor

11 anything for travel or attendance at the legislature
12 connected with the annual county estimates nor
13 for any additional trouble or expense of any kind.
SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-2 proved.
