STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This certifies that I, Benjamin Smith of Appleton, county of Knox and State of Maine, did, on the 12th day of September, 1839, receive a permanent injury while engaged in the service of the State, whereby I have been made a cripple for life, and that as I have never been granted sufficient remuneration, I hereby petition your honorable body that justice may be done in my case.
