STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to repeal an act entitled "An Act to incorporate the town of Lexington."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The act entitled "An Act to incorpor-

- 2 ate the town of Lexington," approved March fourth,
- 3 eighteen hundred and thirty-three, is hereby re-
- 4 pealed; provided, that the corporate existence,
- 5 powers, duties and liabilities of such town shall
- 6 survive for the purpose of prosecuting and de-
- 7 fending all actions or causes of actions to which
- 8 said town is a party, and collecting payment of all
- 9 claims and demands now existing in favor of or

10 against said town, and all needful processes grow-11 ing out of the same.

In case a plantation is organized Sect. 2. 2 within the territory and embracing the limits of 3 such town of Lexington such plantation may at a 4 meeting legally called by a warrant and contain-5 ing an article for that purpose, by vote, assume all 6 the outstanding liabilities of such town on the day 7 when this act takes effect, and in case such planta-8 tion so votes they shall have the authority to raise 9 the money by loan upon plantation orders or notes, 10 which shall be valid claims upon such plantation, 11 with which to discharge such liabilities, and there-12 upon all the property and assets of such town shall 13 become the property of, and vested in, such planta-14 tion, and the provisions of chapter sixty-five of 15 the public laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-16 one shall not apply to such plantation.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when ac-2 cepted, a majority of the legal voters of Lexington 3 present and voting at any legal meeting of said 4 town.
