STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-FIVE.

To Amend Senate Document No. 26.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Amend section two by adding after the word "ferry"
2 in the second line the words 'for twenty years
3 from the date of approval of this act;' and after
4 the tenth line the words '*provided, however, that*
5 this act shall in no way affect the right at present
6 exercised by other parties operating ferries between
7 the points named herein, so that when amended it
8 shall read thus:

'SECT. 2. That said corporation be authorized to
10 carry on and operate a steam ferry for twenty years
11 from the date of approval of this act for the pur-

12 pose of carrying teams of all kinds, such freight
13 as is not prohibited by law, also individual passen-
14 gers, across the Piscataqua river, between, at, or
15 near the end of the Navy Yard bridge, in Navy
16 Yard village, so called, in said Kittery and State of
17 Maine, and to some convenient point in Pepperill's
18 Cove, in said Kittery, and Portsmouth and New-
19 castle in the State of New Hampshire.'

Amend section 6 by striking out all after "section
21 6" and substituting therefor:

'Said corporation may run one or more boats of
23 such construction, power and capacity as the
24 United States steamboat inspectors for the district
25 in which such ferry is run shall approve; but said
26 boats shall not have a less capacity than for two double
27 teams of horses. Said corporation shall provide
28 suitable slips and approaches to its ferry and make
29 such a number of trips each day, between the hours
30 of six in the morning and ten in the evening, as
31 the county commissioners for York County shall
32 direct or approve. For any unreasonable neglect
33 or delay during the hours to be fixed for running
34 as aforesaid, a penalty of one hundred dollars shall
35 be recovered by any party affected thereby, by suit
36 at law or by indictment.'
