## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section fifty-four of chapter forty of the Revised Statutes, relating to the Transportation of Trout and Land-Locked Salmon.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section fifty-four of chapter forty of the Revised

- 2 Statutes is hereby amended so that said section
- 3 as amended shall read as follows:

'SECT. 54. No person shall take, catch, kill, or

- 5 have in possession at any one time for the purpose
- 6 of transportation, more than fifty pounds of land-
- 7 locked salmon, trout or togue in all, nor shall any
- 8 such be transported except in the possession of the
- 9 owner thereof, under a penalty of fifty dollars for
- 10 the offence and five dollars for every pound of

11 land-locked salmon, trout and togue in all, so 12 taken, caught, killed or in possession, or transpor-13 tation, in excess of fifty pounds, and all such fish 14 transported in violation of this section may be 15 seized on complaint, and shall be forfeited to the 16 prosecutor. Whoever has in possession more than 17 fifty pounds in all of such fish, shall be deemed to

18 have taken them in violation of this section.'
