STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE making appropriation for the Passamaquoddy Tribe of Indians for the years of eighteen hundred and eighty-five and eighteen hundred and eighty-six.

Resolved, That there be paid from the State 2 treasury, to be expended under the direction of 3 the governor and council, to the agent of the 4 Passamaquoddy tribe of Indians for the benefit of 5 said tribe, for the years of eighteen hundred and 6 eighty-five and eighteen hundred and eighty-six, 7 as follows: For May dividends, five hundred 8 dollars each year; for November dividends, five 9 hundred dollars each year; for distressed and con-10 tingent poor, three thousand dollars each year; for 11 bounty on crops, three hundred dollars each year; 12 for ploughing, one hundred and fifty dollars each year; for salary of governor, one hundred dollars

14 each year; for salary of lieutenant governor, forty
15 dollars each year; for wood, three hundred dollars
16 each year; contingent purposes, one hundred and
17 fifty dollars each year; for salaries of priests, two
18 hundred dollars each year; for dressing of land,
19 one hundred and fifty dollars each year; for agri20 cultural purposes, six hundred each year; for
21 educational purposes, six hundred dollars each
22 year; for salary of agent, two hundred dollars
23 each year; three hundred dollars for repairs on
24 church and school-house at Peter Dana's Point.
25 All the foregoing sums to be expended under the
26 direction of the governor and council.
