IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
EIGHTY-FIVE.

---

AN ACT additional to Chapter three hundred and  
thirty-one of the Private and Special Laws of  
eighteen hundred and seventy-seven, restricting the  
killing of seal in Casco Bay.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

The main land and islands of Brunswick, Free-  
2 port and Yarmouth and the main land of Cumber-  
3 land, as far southwesterly as the mouth of Broad  
4 Cove, with the island of Great Chebeague and the  
5 islands of Cumberland southeasterly of said  
6 island, are hereby exempted from the provisions of  
7 chapter three hundred and thirty-one of the private  
8 and special laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-  
9 seven, restricting the killing of seal in Casco Bay.
