## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section forty-seven of chapter seventy-seven of the Revised Statutes, in relation to the time of holding the September term of the Supreme Judicial Court, Somerset County.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section forty-seven of chapter 2 seventy-seven of the Revised Statutes is hereby 3 amended, commencing at the fourth line from the 4 bottom on page six hundred and thirty-six, so that 5 that part of said section relating to the time of 6 holding the terms of the supreme judicial courts 7 in and for the county of Somerset shall read as 8 follows, to wit: 'Somerset, at Skowhegan, on the

- 9 first Tuesday of September and the third Tues-10 days of March and December.'
  - Sect. 2. All matters pending in, or returnable
  - 2 to said court and which would, but for the provis-
  - 3 ions of this act, have day at the time of said court
  - 4 to be held on the third Tuesday of September of
  - 5 the present year as provided by law, shall be re-
  - 6 turnable to and have day at the term of said court
  - 7 to be held on the first Tuesday of September next.
    - Sect. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent
  - 2 with this act are hereby repealed, and this act
  - 3 shall take effect when approved.
