STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to authorize the Lewiston and Auburn
Horse Railroad Company to use Steam or Elec-
tricity as a Motive Power.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. The Lewiston and Auburn Horse
2 Railroad Company is hereby authorized and em-
3 powered to use steam or electricity as a motive
4 power on that portion of its road lying between its
5 stable, as now located in the city of Auburn, and
6 the terminus of its road at Lake Auburn; *pro-*
7 *vided, however,* if said corporation shall use steam
8 as aforesaid it shall not employ the ordinary rail-
9 way locomotive engines, but shall confine its use

10 to the noiseless smoke consuming street railway
1 steam motors or cars.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
