STATE OF MAINE.

In House of Representatives, January 15, 1885.

Ordered, That the Committee on Judiciary inquire into the expediency of submitting to a vote by the people a resolve for amending the constitution by changing the time for holding the gubernatorial election from the second Monday of September to the first Tuesday of November, biennially, and report by resolve or otherwise.
