STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT additional to chapter fifty-one of the Revised
Statutes, relating to Railroads.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. No passenger train shall be run
2 over any new railroad, or over any railroad in
3 process of construction, until the railroad commis-
4 sioners have made an inspection of such railroad
5 and granted a certificate of its safety for public
6 travel.

SECT. 2. Any person or corporation violating
2 the provisions of the preceding section forfeits to
3 the State one hundred dollars for each offence, to

4 be recovered in an action on the case or by com-
5 plaint and indictment, and the attorney general
6 shall institute proceedings to recover the same.
