STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section twenty-eight of chapter fifty-one of the Revised Statutes, relating to Railroad Crossings.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section twenty-eight of chapter fifty-one of the 2 Revised Statutes is hereby amended by inserting 3 after the word "highways," in the first line thereof, 4 the words 'or town ways'; and also by striking 5 out all between the word "determined" in the third 6 line thereof, and the word "no" in the eleventh line 7 thereof, and inserting instead of the words thus 8 stricken out the words 'as provided by section 9 twenty-seven of chapter eighteen of the Revised

10 Statutes'; so that said section as amended shall 11 read as follows:

[']SECT. 28. Railroads may cross highways or 13 town ways in the line of the railroad; but cannot 14 pass along them without leave of the town. The 15 conditions and manner of crossing shall be first 16 determined as provided by section twenty-seven of 17 chapter eighteen of the Revised Statutes. No 18 crossing of a street in a city not a highway shall 19 be made without the written consent of the mayor, 20 and aldermen, stating the manner and conditions 21 thereof, to be recorded in the records of the com-22 missioners. Crossings not so made are nuisances 23 and may be so treated, and the directors making 24 them are personally liable.
