STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of John P. Petterson.

Resolved, That the Land Agent is hereby authorized to convey to John P. Petterson lots number thirty-eight and thirty-nine in New Sweden, Aroostook County, with the advice and consent of the Governor and Council.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

John P. Petterson of New Sweden Plantation, Aroostook County, holds the certificates of two lots of land in said New Sweden, numbered 38 and 39. Certificate of lot No. 38 was issued to Alfred Selman, and he sold the same to said John P. Petterson, but neglected to assign the certificate. The certificate of lot 39 was issued to Andrew Johnson, who assigned the same to B. Lundeen, and by him to said John P. Petterson, who has performed nearly all settling duties—built a house and barn and shingle mill. Has lived on the said lots seven years. A large portion of these lots is swamp land, only about 30 acres being suitable for tillage.
