STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and thirtynine of the Revised Statutes, relating to Coroner's Inquests.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Chapter one hundred and thirty-nine of the Re-2 vised Statutes is hereby amended by adding 3 thereto the following section:

'SECT. 13. The evidence of all the witnesses 5 taken at any inquest, shall within ten days after 6 the delivery of the verdict to the coroner, be filed 7 by the coroner with the clerk of courts for the 8 county in which said inquest is held, and there re-9 main open for public inspection.
