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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
EIGHTY-FIVE.

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AN ACT in relation to the Clark and Chaplin Ice  
Company.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. The Clark and Chaplin Ice Com-  
2 pany, or its assigns, may, with the consent of all  
3 the riparian proprietors or persons holding, under  
4 such riparian proprietors, upon Long Creek or its  
5 branches, in the town of Cape Elizabeth, or after  
6 acquiring all the flats and shores of said creek,  
7 maintain a dam across the mouth of said creek,  
8 and flow said creek, and enjoy and have the ex-  
9 clusive right of taking ice from said creek. The  
10 Trustees of the Reform School may consent, in  
11 behalf of the State, to anything hereinbefore con-

12 templated, or may relinquish to said Clark and  
13 Chaplin Ice Company or its assigns, by lease or  
14 sale, all the interests of the State in the flats or  
15 shores of said Long Creek, upon such terms as  
16 said Trustees may consider for the interest of the  
17 Reform School; *provided, however*, that the con-  
18 currence of the city of Portland, in such consent,  
19 lease or sale, be obtained. And *provided*, further,  
20 that this act is subject to all the provisions of the  
21 statutes relative to Portland Harbor, already in  
22 force, or which may be hereafter passed; and that  
23 no dam as aforesaid shall be erected or maintained,  
24 except with the consent of the City Council of  
25 Portland, of the town of Cape Elizabeth and of  
26 the Harbor Commissioners of Portland Harbor,  
27 upon such terms and conditions as may be incor-  
28 porated in such consents.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect on approval.
