RESOLVE in favor of the Town of Orient.

Resolved, That the sum of one hundred and fifty

- 2 dollars be appropriated to aid in building a bridge
- 3 across the thoroughfare between North and Grand
- 4 lakes, in Aroostook county, and to be expended
- 5 under the direction of some person appointed by
- 6 the governor and council; provided, that the in-
- 7 habitants of said town shall raise money for the
- 8 completion of said bridge.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The town of Orient is a small town with less than forty voters. The bridge will have to be built with draw, in order to let the steamboat through. The bridge will cost \$600 and the town is not able to build it.
