Resolved, That the Secretary of State be directed 2 to furnish to the town of Littleton the following 3 books: volumes one, two, three, four, five, six, 4 seven, eight,ten, eleven, twelve, fourteen, seventeen, 5 nineteen, twenty-four, twenty-five, twenty-six, 6 twenty-seven, twenty-eight, twenty-nine, thirty, 7 thirty-one, thirty-eight, thirty-nine, forty-three, 8 forty-four, forty-six, forty-nine, fifty, fifty-four, 9 fifty-five, sixty-eight and sixty-nine of the Maine 10 Reports, so far as the same or any part thereof can 11 be furnished without injury to the State, to replace 12 volumes belonging to said town destroyed by fire. .
