STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section thirty-one of chapter forty-six of the Revised Statutes relating to Clerks' and Treasurers' Reports.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION. 1. Section thirty-one of chapter forty-

- 2 six of the Revised Statutes is amended by striking
- 3 out the word "by" in the first line and inserting
- 4 in place thereof the words 'between the first day
- 5 of November,' and inserting after the words "paid
- 6 in" in the fourth line, the words 'on said first day
- 7 of November', so that said section as amended will
- 8 read as follows:

'SECT. 31. Such cashiers and clerks or treasurers 10 shall between the first day of November and the

- 11 eighth day of December annually, make return to
- 12 the Secretary of State of the names of all stock
- 13 holders, their residences, the amount of stock
- 14 owned by each, and the whole amount of stock
- 15 paid in, on said first day of November. The sec-
- 16 retary shall lay the same before the legislature
- 17 within the first thirty days of the session.'
 - SECT. 2. This act shall take effect on approval 2 by the governor.
