STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to provide for Inventories by Assignees in Insolvency.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- The judge may, at any time, direct the assignee
- 2 to make and return upon oath into the court of
- 3 insolvency a true inventory of all the property of
- 4 the debtor, real and personal, which the assign-
- 5 ment vests in such assignee, and which has come
- 6 to his possession or knowledge; and the estate
- 7 comprised in such inventory shall be appraised in
- 8 the same manner that the estates of deceased per-
- 9 sons are required by law to be appraised.
- 10 inventory and appraisement shall be made and re-
- 11 turned at such time as the judge may direct.
